Work projects are open to all--no prior experience is necessary. Please note that some projects require a moderate hike to and from the work site, and others will be off-trail adventures.




All participants must sign up at <u>outdoors.org</u>. A link for each project is also usually provided below. We generally meet at the trailhead at 9am and are headed back to arrive at the trailhead no later than 4pm. If you only have a partial day available, we'd be happy to accommodate you-just let the project leader know.

Note: Projects for the season will conform to AMC and ATC Covid-19 work requirements. Face coverings will be required when social distancing cannot be maintained, crew sizes may be limited. Participants must provide their own face coverings, work gloves and hand sanitizer. YOU MUST PRE-REGISTER for ALL PROJECTS.
